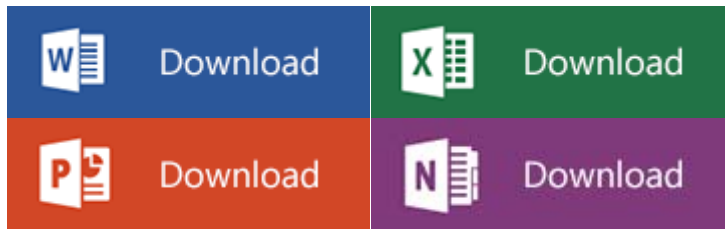


How do I install the Office365 applications on my iOS (Apple) device?

If you sign in to the app with a free Microsoft account or an work or school account associated with a [qualifying Office 365](#) subscription, you'll have access to the app's [extra features](#) as well as [other Office 365 apps](#) for iOS.

NOTE: Are you on a MacBook or Mac? You will have to [install the desktop version of Office](#).




1. Tap any Office app like **Word** to launch it.
2. Tap **Sign in** if you already have a Microsoft Account or an Office 365 work or school account.

NOTE: Or tap **Create an Account** to create a new Microsoft Account using any email address you already have.



3. Enter your personal Microsoft account or your work or school account. Tap **Next**.

NOTE: For a new Microsoft Account, create a password and then follow the prompts to verify your identity.

4. Enter the password associated with your account and tap **Sign in**.

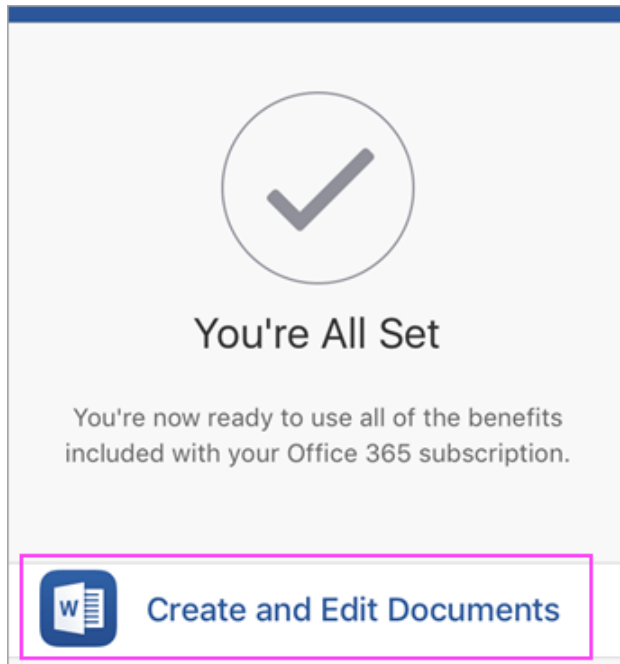

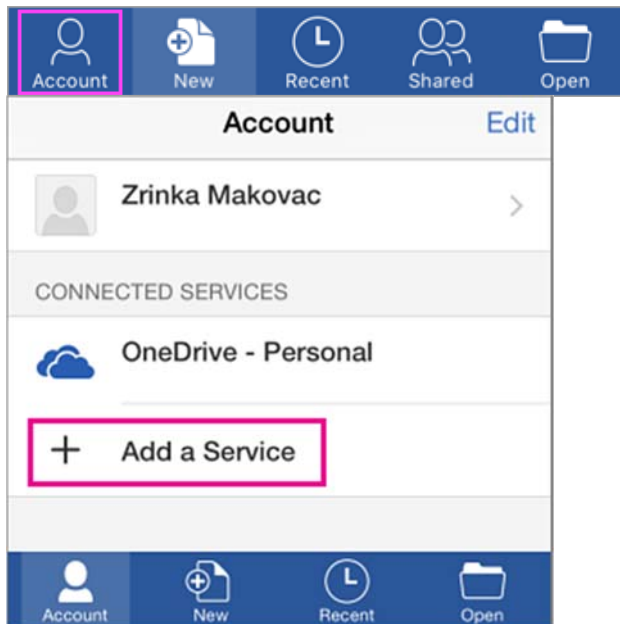
Tap **Turn on Notifications** to enable alerts or **Not Now** to opt out.

5. Tap **Create and Edit Documents** to start working on your documents.

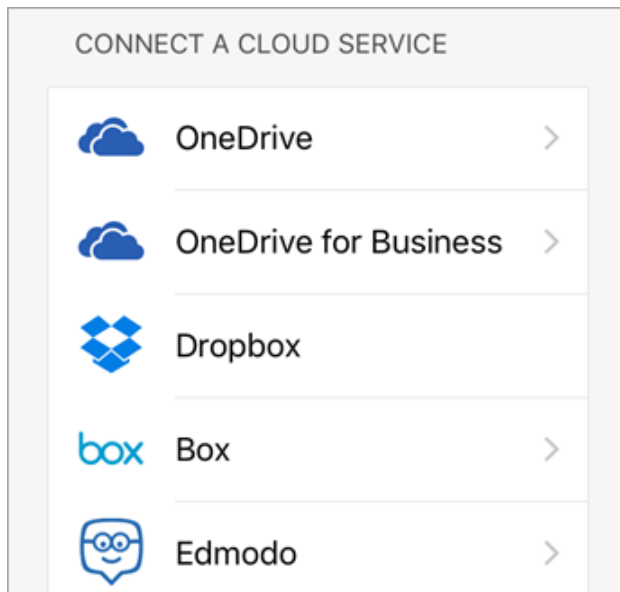
TIP: After you sign in, your account is automatically added to the other Office apps installed on your iOS device.



6. To add another account, like OneDrive for Business or Dropbox, tap **Account** > **Add a Service**.
If you are using OneNote, tap **Settings** > **Accounts**.



7. Choose the cloud service that you want to add.



Enter the email address and password that you use to sign into that service.
You are good to go!
